The nearby **Suffolk Heritage Coastline** and its surrounding countryside have much to offer. The seaside resort of **Southwold**, is well known for its traditional beach huts, lighthouse and the Adnams Brewery, *still delivering their traditional ales by horse and dray!*

**We are within easy reach** of the historic and beautiful city of **Norwich** with its 900 year Norman Cathedral, Castle and colourful market place. **Norwich City Centre** boasts a blend of ancient and modern. Georgian town houses, over 30 flint churches and many museums are set alongside the ultra-modern Castle Mall Shopping Centre, department stores, specialist shops and its famous Colmans Mustard Shop.

Just a short drive away, is **Great Yarmouth** a popular seaside resort, with its pleasure beach, amusements, theatres, brilliant illuminations and lively nightlife.

**Other local places of interest** include **Dunwich, Aldeburgh**, with its famous *Snape Festival of Music and Arts in June*. **Lavenham** - A beautiful town with an abundance of 14/16<sup>th</sup>-century timber framed houses.

**Of particular interest** to our many friends from the **USA**, are the former Second World War Air Bases of **Seething, Flixton, Topcroft** and **Hardwick**. Many have museums and monuments in recognition of the American contribution.

For Guests who prefer to leave their car behind, frequent buses run through **Woodton village** to the picturesque town of **Bungay** (5 miles) and **Norwich** (10 miles)
